## 1 AD-DSL and IPC-1754 Standard

The Aerospace and Defense Declarable Substances List (AD-DSL) is available in multiple formats: Microsoft Excel (.XLSX), PDF format and XML format.

The AD-DSL is compatible with the IPC-1754 data exchange standard (version 1.0, amendment 2, noted “4.1”) and its SubstanceList schema (XSD) controlling the XML format of the list.

The AD-DSL is provided with its own schema (XSD) extending the IPC-1754 schema for SubstanceList.

## 2 AD-DSL Content Change History

AD-DSL V8.2 update includes

- **corrections to ‘Deletions’ tab:** substances that were inadvertently dropped from V8.1 have been restored
- **corrected ‘Date First Added’ column for substances added in 2024:** these substances were incorrectly attributed to 2023 in V8.1
- **Duplicate Substance Removal:** IAEG009173 has been deleted as a duplicate, while IAEG009182 has been retained due to its association with the preferred CAS No.

AD-DSL V8.1 has been updated to include corrections to the IAEG Regulatory Criteria on the AD-DSL Microsoft Excel (.XLSX) and PDF format.

AD-DSL version 8.0 has been updated to include additional declarable substances because information on the usage of these substances in the AD supply chain is of concern to IAEG® for chemicals management and reporting purposes. 252 substances were removed from the AD-DSL; a list of deleted substances can be found on the deletions tab along with the date and reason for deletion.

European Chemicals Agency identification numbers (“ECHA IDs”) were incorporated into V4.1-V6.0 of the AD-DSL as an additional data element. ECHA IDs have been removed from the AD-DSL in order to keep the AD-DSL regulatorily agnostic.

Schema location has been updated to reflect the new version 4.1f:

Note that namespace is kept as <http://www.iaeg.com/chemicalrpt/addsl/4.1> because it reflects main version of the schema and is not sensitive to error fix.

### 3 AD-DSL Schema Change History

AD-DSL XSD Schema version 4.1 has been fixed for a minor error regarding schema version.

AD-DSL Schema 4.1f is considered backwards compatible because previous version 4.1e was erroneous.
