
IAEG Round up

The [2024 Annual Report – Fueling our Growth](#), could be considered pre-work for all members, new and existing, to read as they prepare for the IAEG Spring meeting. This year, the Strategic Planning Committee (SPC) requested the work groups reflect on the last five years and share a few key deliverables or milestones they achieved as part of the IAEG Vision 2025. Not only are these accomplishments the hallmarks of the work and commitment the members do to support the Aerospace and Defense Industry, but they also serve to validate IAEG’s vision.

With change a constant, here are some new things the work groups are tackling in 2025:

- WG 3 Collaboration to develop a Military Use of Sold Products (USP) guidance and Science Based Targets (SBT) white paper with other industry groups
- WG5 Prepare for EU REACH Revision and/or further EU/UK REACH divergence
- WG 7 Development of a maturity level registration tracking method
- WG 9 Expansion to include social & governance regulations, collaborative with WG 11 & 14
- WG 11 Launch Take Off Resource Hub, Publish Supplier Engagement Toolkit
- WG 12 Publish Version 1 of the Life Cycle Assessment (LCA) Framework
- WG 13 Kick off additional compatibility projects
- WG 14 Industry white papers on composites circularity challenges and circular economy blockers for the aerospace industry

The SPC is updating the ‘heatmap tool’ which analyzes industry relevant sustainability topics to identify and prioritize IAEG opportunities that could impact Aerospace and Defense Industry. The heatmap supports the development of ideas into the formation of workgroups and is aligned with the vision update shown below.




Upcoming Events
