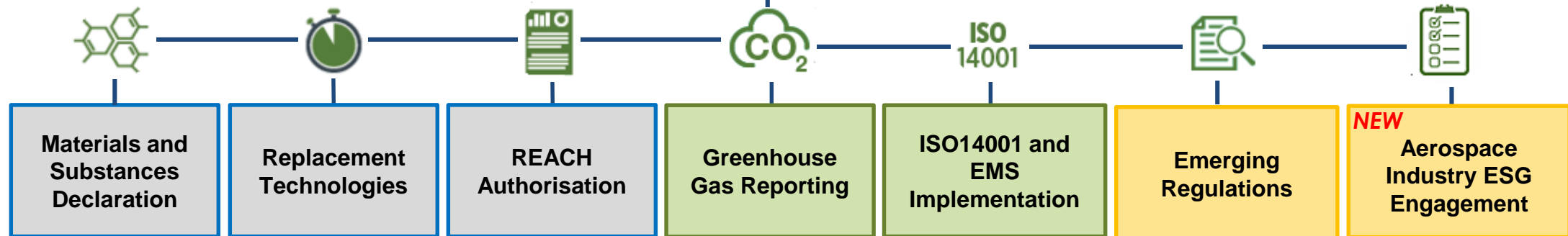

SHARING OF GOOD PRACTICES

Membership eligibility determination

1. Principally engaged in carrying out design, manufacture or support of civilian or military aerospace original equipment, systems, or structures, of aircraft, rotorcraft, satellites and/or space exploration vehicles;
2. Major Supplier earning at least \$100 million in annual revenues as a supplier to Aerospace Companies; or
3. Supplier, regardless of the total revenue, has at least 80% of its annual revenue from Aerospace Companies

2023 Annual Membership Fees

Full Member

If at least one of the above criteria applies, and the applicant is NOT a subsidiary of a company already a Full Member of IAEG®:

>\$10B average annual revenue (for the last 3 years, based on an exchange rates on December 31st, 2020) \$24,200

<\$10B average annual revenue (for the last 3 years, based on an exchange rates on December 31st, 2020) \$18,150

If neither of the above criteria does not apply, or the applicant is a subsidiary of a company already a Full Member of IAEG
